## What is the IPC?

- Commissioner Kosseim appointed 2020
- Mandate to oversee Ontario access and privacy legislation
- Divided amongst policy, tribunal, and corporate services
- Amongst other elements of mandate:
  - Conduct research and provide comment
  - Educate Ontarians on privacy laws and current issues

## Defining "Privacy"

- Where does privacy come from? What is it? Is it the same, everywhere?
- Does privacy really matter, or exist, anymore?

## Privacy in the Social Media Era

- The implication of "blurred" context for public, semi-public, and private material
- Is it the content, or the metadata, that matters? And to whom?
- Privacy, permanency, and human memory

- Expansions in domestic and international collections of personal information for government investigations
