[1] The Information and Privacy Commissioner of Ontario seeks an order sealing portions of the record of proceedings of the Commissioner to be filed in the application for judicial review of Order P-1356, as well as an order restricting access to the sealed material.

[2] Having considered the material filed and the submissions of counsel, I am satisfied it is in the interest of justice to grant the order requested. Disclosure of the records in question would predetermine the Judicial Review Application, which among other things, involves the very issue of confidentiality.

[3] Accordingly, an order shall issue pursuant to Section 4 of the *Judicial Review Procedure Act*, that the portions of the Commissioner's record of proceeding in issue be treated as confidential, sealed and access to the private record shall be given to counsel for Tectonic upon the filing of the usual undertaking of confidentiality. There shall be no costs.
